



## Univerzijada 2009. u Beogradu

### 2009 Universiade in Belgrade

– Beograd će u julu 2009. godine biti domaćin 25. letnje Univerzijade

– In July 2009, Belgrade will host the 25th Summer Universiade

**U**niverzijada Beograd biće najveći sportski događaj u svetu 2009. godine i najveća i najmasovnija u istoriji univerzitetskih igara, jer će joj prisustvovati više od 12 hiljada sportista iz 170 zemalja, koji će se takmičiti u 21 sportu.

Posle Olimpijskih igara, Univerzijada je najveće i najmasovnije sportsko takmičenje koje se može organizovati u jednoj zemlji. Održava se svake druge godine u nekom od gradova zemalja – članica Međunarodne federacije univerzitetskog sporta. Organizacija Univerzijade se dodeljuje po sličnom principu kao i organizacija olimpijskih igara i predstavlja veliku čast i odgovornost za državu i grad kojima je dodeljena.

Do početka Univerzijade u Beogradu ostalo više od godinu dana, a pripreme u glavnom gradu Srbije su već uveliko u toku. Na 13,8 hektara površine u atraktivnom delu Grada niče reprezentativno Univerzitetsko selo, u čiju gradnju će biti uloženo oko 200 miliona evra. Naselje se sastoji od 14 stambenih objekata i dve poslovne zgrade. Biće izgrađeno 31.386 m<sup>2</sup> poslovnog prostora, 1.788 stanova različitih struktura, 333 lokala u prizemlju stambenih zgrada i 2.543 parking mesta u podzemnim garažama i na otvorenim parking prostorima. Posle Univerzijade ovo će biti reprezentativno stambeno naselje sa najmodernijom infrastrukturom i svim objektima neophodnim za život „grada u gradu“.

Za potrebe Univerzijade Beograd 2009. biti preuređeni i rekonstruisani mnogi sportski objekti u Beogradu i obližnjim gradovima. Za treninge i takmičenja biće angažovano više od 60 objekata, pa će to, bez sumnje, biti i značajan legat ove manifestacije svim Beograđanima i gostima glavnog grada, bilo da su aktivni sportisti ili rekreativci.

Na Univerzijadi Beograd 2009. učestvovalaće i više od 10 hiljada volontera, i već sada je potpuno jasno da će ovo biti pravi festival druženja i dobre volje među mladim ljudima. Preko satelitskih televizijskih mreža pratiće ga milioni gledalaca širom planete. Energija zdravog, sportskog duha, akademizma i mladosti svakako će doprineti da ono što iz Beograda i Srbije ode tih dana u svet bude slika kojoj će se svi radovati.

**U**niversiade Belgrade will be the largest sports event in the world in 2009 and the biggest and most massive in the history of the University Games, since it will be attended by more than 12 thousand athletes from 170 countries, competing in 21 sports.

After the Olympic Games, the Universiade is the largest and most massive sports event a country can organize. It is held every second year in a city of one of the member countries of the International University Sports Federation. The organization of the Universiade is awarded according to a similar principle as the organization of the Olympic Games and it represents a big honor and responsibility for the state and city to which it is awarded.

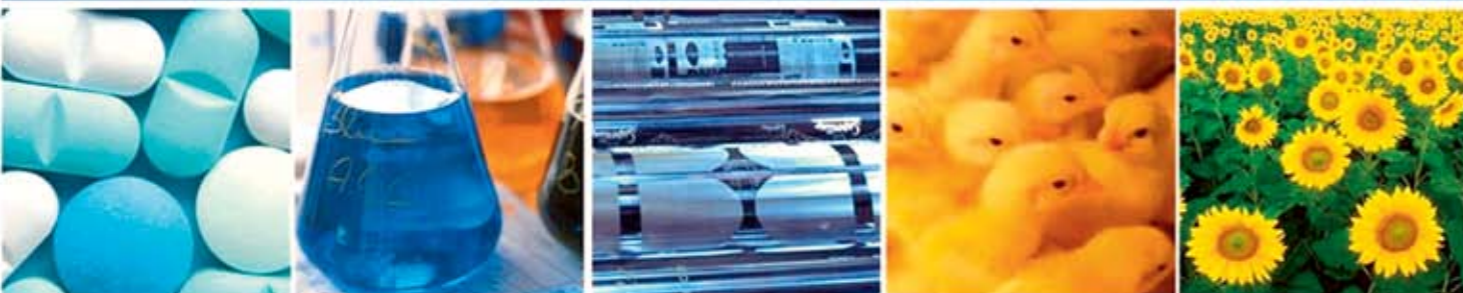
There is more than a year left to the beginning of the Universiade in Belgrade, but preparations in the Serbian capital are well underway. A representative University village is springing up on 13.8 hectares in an attractive part of the City, with around 200 million euros having been invested in it. The village consists of 14 housing facilities and two commercial buildings. Constructed will be 31,386 m<sup>2</sup> of business space, 1,788 apartments of various structures, 33 shops on the ground floors of the apartment buildings and 2,543 parking spaces in the underground garages and on outdoor parking lots. After the Universiade, this will be a representative housing settlement with the most modern infrastructure and with all the facilities necessary for the life of a “city within a city”.

Numerous sports facilities in Belgrade and the nearby towns will be redesigned and reconstructed for the needs of Universiade Belgrade 2009. Over 60 facilities will be engaged for the trainings and competitions which will, undoubtedly, represent this event’s important legacy to all Belgraders and the capital’s guests, be they engaged in sports actively or on a recreational basis.

More than 10 thousand volunteers will also participate in Universiade Belgrade 2009, and it is clear already now that this will be a real festival of companionship and good will among young people. It will be watched by millions of viewers throughout the planet via satellite television networks. The energy of a healthy, sports spirit, academism and youth will quite certainly contribute to the picture going out from Belgrade and Serbia into the world during those days being one that many will be glad to see.
